
Underwear-Plea

Illnesses

It is important to minimise the spread of infection in school as much as possible. If your child is unwell and are experiencing a fever, they should stay home from school or nursery until they feel better and the fever has resolved. We understand that absences can be a concern for you, however, we will take this into consideration when looking into persistent absences. Strong reminder that if your child has experienced any sickness and/or diarrhoea, they MUST stay off school for 48 hours after the last bout.

We would like to remind parents and carers that you must notify the school if your child will not be present at school or nursery. You can report absences via ParentMail, or, alternatively, please leave a message on the absence line; **remember**, absences must be reported daily. We thank you for your continued co-operation.

We have seen an increase in other ailments and illnesses and have included the Public Health Agency infection control guidance below for your reference. Please use this NHS <u>link</u> for further clarification if the illness your child is experiencing is not on the table below.

If your child needs to take medication at school, for example; anti-biotics, then please come to the office to fill out the appropriate forms.

Please note that we do not administer over-the-counter medicines like Calpol, for coughs and colds. However, there are some exceptional circumstances in which we will administer these medications to your child. Please come and speak to the office and to fill in appropriate forms.
